




Changing Your APS Password (Student)



1. Change your APS Password

1. Go to  on the dock.
2. Select **Resources - Change My Password** 
3. Sign in using your current account login and password
4. Type your current password and then type your new password two times. Your new password must be at least 10 characters long. Make sure you see **Match!** after you type the new password twice.


2. Change your computer password (you want your passwords to match)
