Changes in Social Studies - MS Economics (-0.1), World Languages - Shifting numbers in Spanish (-0.2), Fine Arts - Merging Music Theory and AP Music Theory, and decrease in film total in a (-0.4). There is .05 (one quarter) remaining which will be used for outside teacher funding or needs. School board budget is being passed tonight, we are also yet to receive advanced contingency
