

### Requirements for a Standard Diploma.

Students shall earn the required standard and verified units of credit. To graduate with a Standard Diploma, a student must earn at least 22 standard units of credit by passing required courses and electives, and earn at least five verified credits by passing end-of-course SOL tests or other assessments approved by the Board of Education.
